**NEW BUILD AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER (ATC) AT BASTION AIRFIELD (BNAF)
PROJECT NUMBER 4982**

1. The New ATC at BSN was handed over to the Operating Authority on 15 Feb 11, pending the completion of a number of snagging items. Since that point, the vast majority of snags have been completed to the customer's satisfaction and only a few final items remain¹. We are now left with a building that is fit for purpose and meets the original requirement. Once the external communications equipment installation is completed², we will be left with a building that exceeds expectations and provides the UK and Coalition Partners with an enhanced airfield capability to support operations in Afghanistan.
2. Over the past 6 months we have been impressed by the ability of FEKA as a construction partner in such extreme conditions as is posed by construction to UK standards in Afghanistan.
